Directions & Parking Info:

Directions to the Sandler Center are available online @ www.sandlercenter.org, or you may call 385-2525. There will be no charge for parking. There are convenient parking garages in town center. Enter through the performer's entrance; there will be a bundle of balloons at the door, so it should be easy to find.

DRESS REHEARSAL Thursday, June 25th.

DRESS REHEARSAL IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC!!!!

(Only Performers, a parent/guardian, and one person to video are permitted) Everyone must check-in at the with office staff!!

THIS IS IMPORTANT!

There will be someone checking the auditorium for un-permitted individuals!

Dress Rehearsal Information:

Dancers are to arrive at the Sandler Center on Thursday, June 25th **NO EARLIER** than **4:30 P.M** with make-up on. An accessory page will be handed out with costumes. If you do not receive your accessory list, please check with your teacher before Dress Rehearsal! **DO NOT** wear your costume to the Sandler Center. We will be using the back stage dressing rooms. There will be dressing room assignments located on each dressing room door for specific routines. After checking in, please locate your designated dressing room and put on your first costume. As soon as you're dressed and ready, proceed to the auditorium and sit with your class. We will start Dress Rehearsal as soon as the Sandler Center crew is ready. Please, **NO** jewelry (unless part of costume), **NO** fingernail polish, and **NO** underpants (except boys) are to be worn with costumes! Video taping is allowed for Dress Rehearsal ONLY! One person per student, please. L4 Enterprises, Inc., a professional video company will tape the performance on Friday and Saturday.

Order forms are available on our site, and there will be a table set up at the shows. FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY IS NOT ALLOWED!! This is very dangerous to the dancers as it can cause injury to the students as well as others.

Account Information:

ALL account balances must be paid in full by Wednesday, June 24th in order for students to perform in the show. Please direct any questions to office staff prior to dress rehearsal.

Ticket Information:

Performance tickets are on sale now. You may get yours at the Sandler Center Box Office or on their website. Tickets are \$28.00. If you are purchasing tickets for both nights, it will cost \$25 for Friday and \$25 for Saturday. Only if the tickets are bought at the same time! It is advisable to purchase your tickets in advance because there is assigned seating. Tickets will, however; be available at the door on the day of the show, for \$28.00 as well.

Pre-show Award Information:

All students who received a certificate pertaining to an awards ceremony at Tech rehearsal should read the following information.

When you check-in at Dress Rehearsal, the office staff will advise you as to which night you will receive your award. Pre-show awards (credit awards as well as Jr. & Sr. Graduates) will be held at 6:15 both nights, so these students should arrive at the Sandler Center at 5:15. Jr. & Sr. graduate escorts should be there NO LATER THAN 5:45. Ask Jessica for directions.

Performance Information:

Dancers must arrive NO EARLIER THAN 5:30 PM with make-up already on. PLEASE ALLOW TIME FOR TRAFFIC ISSUES!! Enter through the same door as dress rehearsal. Check in at the table as soon as you arrive. Use the same

dressing room as the day of the dress rehearsal. ONLY ONE PERSON WILL BE ALLOWED PER CHILD BACKSTAGE. This person must show a ticket stub at the check-in table, and he/she will also receive a stamp to allow him/her to re-enter the backstage area. The Sandler Center crew WILL NOT LET YOU ENTER THE LOBBY AND THEATER WITHOUT A TICKET. PARENTS WHO ARE ASSISTING STUDENTS MUST HAVE A STAMPED HAND TO GET BACKSATAGE! Students should dress in there first costume and wait in the rehearsal hall until it is time for them to perform. Our backstage crew will assist you in lining up for your performance. **THEY DO NOT HAVE TIME TO SEARCH FOR PERFORMERS!!** If you are only performing once in the second or third act, you may watch the performance in the rehearsal hall through video feed until it is time for you to get ready to perform. Make sure you are ready to go at least 6 numbers before your routine! After students are finished performing, they must remain in the rehearsal hall unless he/she is small enough to sit in a parents lap. We do NOT have tickets for students! Each person, except performers, must have a ticket. There will be a video feed into the rehearsal hall.

MOTHERS OF YOUNG CHILDREN:

Please come back to the dressing room as soon as your child has finished performing. After performing, children must change clothes. LEAVE COSTUMES IN THE DRESSING ROOM UNTIL AFTER THE SHOW!

ABSOLUTELY NO COSTUMES ARE ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM!

Please remember that we are guests, and we should clean up after ourselves. DO NOT LEAVE TRASH IN THE DRESSING ROOMS!!
